We are proud that our tenants participate in recycling paper, cardboard, glass, aluminum and plastic. To further the program, we provide tenants with the following containers:

- Desktop Containers for Single Sort Recyclables. Located at each desk and workstation.
- Intermediate Container for Single Sort Recyclables. Located in breakrooms and copy rooms.

Single Sort Recyclables:

- Plastic: Rinse before recycling
 - Bottles, containers, tubs and lids (#1-#7)
- Containers: Rinse food from items before recycling
 - o Aluminum, steel, tin cans
 - Food jars
 - o Glass jars and bottles
 - Pie tins
- Paper: Break down large items
 - Mail, envelopes, post it notes, copy paper
 - Newspaper and inserts
 - Magazines, catalogs, newsletters
 - Brown grocery bags
 - Phone books
 - Shredded paper (in closed paper bags)
 - Cereal, cracker, pasta boxes
 - Dairy and juice cartons (rinse out before recycling)
 - Soda boxes, shoe boxes, gift boxes
 - Electronics boxes
 - Cardboard, flattened

Non Recyclables:

- Auto, mirror or tinted glass
- Blueprints, transparencies, photograhic and carbon paper
- Food waste, styrofoam, egg cartons and foil containers
- Facial tissues, paper towels and napkins
- Carpeting, clothing
- Hazardous waste or containers
- Plastic bags, light bulbs
- Overnight or padded envelopes
- Self adhesive labels, hanging files, file folders
- Wax coated boxes, rubber-type materials, latex
- Metal or steel objects such as nails, wire, hangers or case strapping

E-Waste and battery recycling available upon request. Shorenstein Realty Services also hosts an E-Waste Recycling event once a year in which you can bring computers, electronics, light bulbs, batteries, etc.



Source Separated Organics Acceptable Material List*

Acceptable materials for organics recycling include:

- All FOOD scraps
- All grass, leaves, yard trimmings, plant trimmings
- All non-recyclable PAPER products
 - Napkins, paper towels, tissues
 - o Paper plates, cups & food containers
 - o Paper milk & juice cartons
 - Paper bags & waxed paper (fast food wraps, etc.)
 - o Coffee grounds, filters & tea bags
 - Pizza boxes
- All compostable products as certified by the Biodegradable Products Institute (bpiworld.org)

Unacceptable materials:

- PLASTICS of any kind including, Styrofoam, plastic bottles, condiment packets, chip bags & candy wrappers and compostable plastics that do not meet BPI Certification standards.
- Glass
- Diapers, sanitary products
